

## Statement from His Excellency the Ambassador Extraordinary & Plenipotentiary of the State of Qatar to the United Kingdom, Fahad bin Mohammed Al-Attiyah, on the passing of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II

I am deeply saddened to learn of the passing of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II and would like to express my deepest condolences to the Royal Family and the British people, on behalf of the State of Qatar.

Her Majesty enjoyed a historic 70-year reign since her accession to the throne in 1952, throughout which she has always been a constant beacon of stability and continuity in the face of extraordinary change at home and abroad, and the world is a much richer place thanks to her decades of public service. Queen Elizabeth II served throughout some of the most historic moments in the relationship between Qatar and the United Kingdom, and the bonds between our two countries have grown stronger throughout her reign.
